- **Researchers**

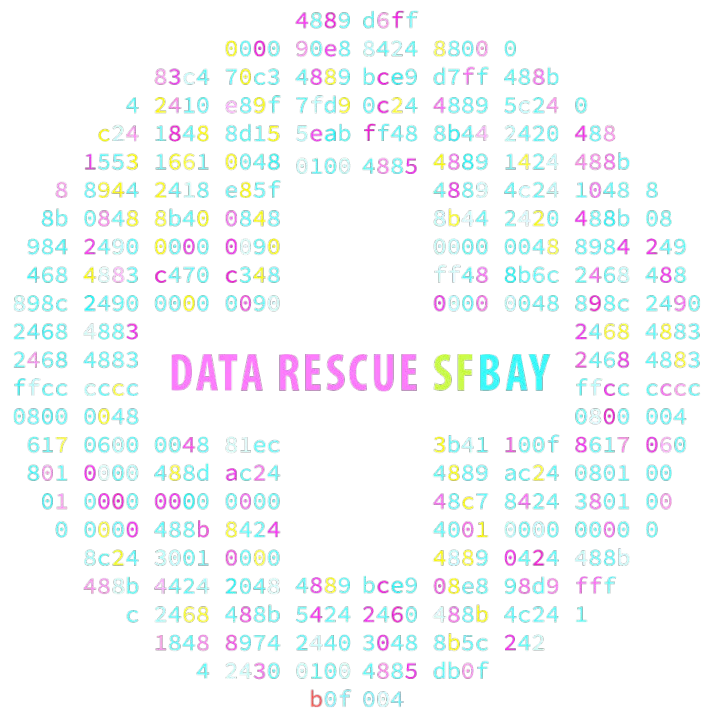

**\*Storytelling**=`<#storytelling><TBA in slack channel>` **Sessions In the Afternoon**

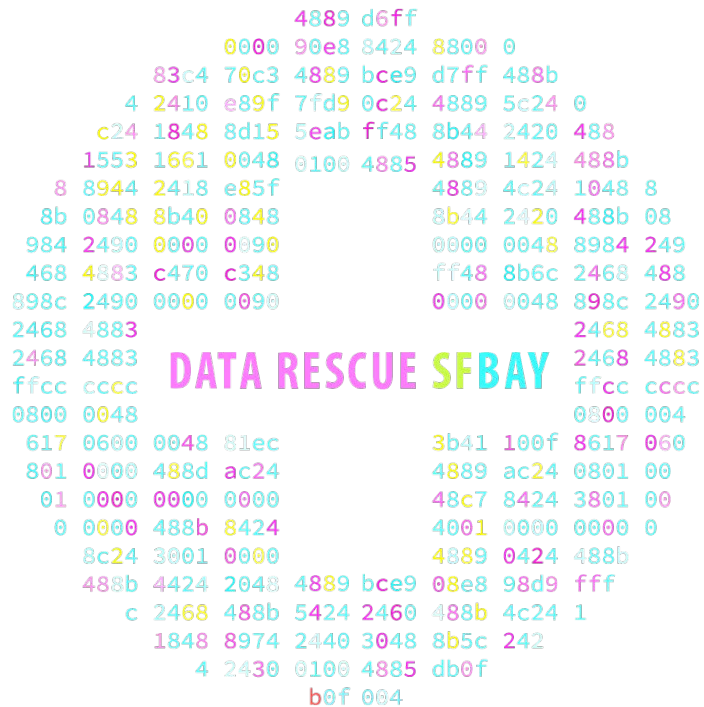
